Illinois Assessment of Readiness

Our students in grades 6-8 take required assessments every year in the spring. The assessments provide teachers and families valuable information on student progress and achievement. This year, students in grades 6-8 will take the Illinois Assessment of Readiness (IAR). IAR is aligned to the Common Core State Standards and provides information on student skills that are important for college and career success.

Students will complete test sessions in both English language arts (ELA) and mathematics. During the ELA test sessions, students will read multiple passages, answer questions and write responses in literary analysis, research tasks, and narrative tasks. For the math test sessions, students will solve problems using mathematical logic and reasoning.

The IAR is scheduled at Fred Rodgers Magnet Academy on Wednesday, March 6th, through Friday, March 8th, and again on Wednesday, March 13th, through Friday, March 15th.

Every day our school community focuses on student learning and growth. In order for our students to achieve their best, please make sure your child has a good night of sleep and eats a healthy breakfast. Breakfast is available every morning for all students in our building. Students will also need their fully charged Chromebooks each day of testing.
