Attendance

Our school is a better place with as many students present as possible.

The goal of the attendance policies and procedures of the District will be to support and improve the regular attendance and performance of our students. These policies can be found in the Parent-Student Handbook located on the district website. Regular attendance, coupled with student effort, is a critical factor in learning and being successful in school.

If your student will be absent, please call the main office at 630-299-7175 to report the absence.

Attendance is considered an important part of each class grade. Excessive absences will negatively affect the grade or credit for that class. Absences are categorized as excused or unexcused. Valid causes of absenteeism (excused), as listed in the Illinois School Code, are:

- Illness
- Observance of a religious holiday (See Board Policy)
- Death in the immediate family
- Family emergency

- Circumstances that cause reasonable concern to the parent or guardian for the safety or health of the student
- Other situations beyond the control of the student, as determined by the Board of Education.

All other absences will be considered unexcused, including vacations taken during school attendance days. Prearranged excused absences must be approved by the principal. We may require documentation explaining the reason for the student's absence. As always, please contact me if you have any questions about your student's attendance.

Curriculum Night

Mark your calendars for our Curriculum Night on Thursday, September 12th, from 5:30-7:00 p.m. at the school. This is a great opportunity to meet your child's teachers and hear about upcoming learning activities. More information will be sent home prior to the event.
