We are excited to begin the process of preparing your eighth-grade students for their transition to East Aurora High School. A crucial step in this process is course selection, which will significantly impact your child's academic journey.

Course Selection Process:

To ensure a smooth transition, we will be offering presentation sessions to each eighth-grade student on the following dates:

• January 21, Fred Rodgers

January 23, Simmons

• January 22, Waldo

• January 24, Cowherd

During these sessions, counselors will discuss course options, answer questions, and provide guidance to help students make informed decisions.

A Typical Freshman Schedule:

At the high school we offer a block schedule where classes meet for 90 minutes every other day. A typical freshman schedule will include the following core courses:

- Pre-AP Algebra 1 or Pre-AP Geometry
- Pre-AP Biology
- Pre-AP World History and Geography
- Pre-AP English 1
- Physical Education, Marching Band, or NJROTC

Additionally, students may qualify for **Math Boost** or **Reading Intervention** based on their MAP scores. Students will be taking the MAP Exam in January. Please encourage your student to do their best during this test to ensure we match interventions to student needs. Both Math Boost and Reading Intervention programs are designed to provide extra support and help students succeed academically.

Elective Courses and Synergy:

Most freshmen students will have the opportunity to select an elective course such as art, band, choir, theater, business, applied technology, computer science, NJROTC, culinary, health and human services, and many others. A full list of elective options is available through the following link:
