<u>Illinois Math and Science Academy (IMSA) Presentation:</u> Representatives from IMSA will be providing a presentation to eligible students and parents on Thursday, December 11th from 5:00pm-6:00pm in the LRC. The presentation will be provided in both English and Spanish. There are two IMSA programs that will be discussed- IMSA Promise and IMSA Admissions.

IMSA Promise eligibility:

- Current 7th or 8th grade student
- A's and B's in all classes since 6th grade (No grades below a "B")
- Scores greater than the 50th percentile on NWEA MAP assessments
- Interest in STEM

IMSA Admissions eligibility (high school):

- Current 8th grade student
- Mostly A's in all classes since 6th grade (All A's preferred)
- Must take the ACT or SAT
- Must be enrolled in or have completed the equivalent of Algebra 1 and a high school equivalent science course (science course must be taken online as we do not provide a high school level science course at FRMA). Most students opt to take Biology.
