Upward Bound Program: There are two Upward Bound programs available to 8th grade students which will start the summer after their 8th grade year:

Waubonsee: Waubonsee's Upward Bound program provides FREE support for college readiness and has an office at EAHS. The program coordinator, Elisa Nino, will be presenting to all 8th grade students during their science class on Wednesday, February

Northern Illinois University: NIU's Upward Bound program is a FREE college preparatory program that provides academic counseling, skill development, general preparation and placement for students who plan to continue their education after high school. Students are not required to attend NIU after high school to be part of the Upward Bound Program. The NIU program has a 6 week summer residency requirement in which students are required to live on campus. Applications are currently available in my office- encourage your student to stop by and grab one from me. NIU has shared that there are only a handful of spaces available for new applicants, so if your student is interested, please have them see me.
